Keeping ahead of the pack: a smoking prevention resource for use with lower secondary school students

Suitable for use with lower secondary school students, this resource includes a teacher booklet and DVD. Included in the teacher booklet are more than 10 cross curriculum activities that are linked to the WA Curriculum Framework. The 12 minute DVD supports these activities and features local WA personalities from 92.9, Channel 9 and the Fremantle Football Club. Support materials, such as worksheets, scenario cards, quizzes and Smarter than Smoking Fact Sheets are also included on the DVD and can be downloaded and printed using your PC.

Ideas Kit for Upper Primary Teachers

This Kit includes over 18 cross curriculum activity ideas for upper primary teachers to creatively teach young people about tobacco and smoking related issues, such as, physical, environmental and social consequences of smoking, dealing with pressures to smoke and reasons for not smoking. Also included in the Kit are whole school activities, ideas for home, fact sheets and other support materials.

Clearing the Air: Talking with Children and Teenagers about Smoking

This brochure aims to assist parents and other adults in talking with children and teenagers about smoking. The professional literature suggests parental influence has a significant impact on a child or teenager's decision to smoke, and therefore the brochure provides tips on what parents (and other adults) can do and say to encourage young people to remain smoke free.

Critics' Choice DVD

Critics' Choice is a free innovative anti-tobacco resource for upper primary and lower secondary schools. Students watch, critique and discuss 12 anti-smoking advertisements and then vote on the one most likely to prevent them from taking up smoking or encourage them most to stop.



Smarter than Smoking Fact Sheets

A series of four fact sheets useful for student assignments covering topics such as: *Facts about smoking, What's in a cigarette, The effects of smoking on the body, Effects of cigarette smoking on being active, Second hand smoke, Tobacco and the environment, Tobacco and the law in Australia and Smoking and the media.*
