

Youth Tobacco Free Day 2010

On-line Competition Terms and Conditions



1. The Promoter is the Heart Foundation (WA Division) on behalf of *Australian Network on Young People and Tobacco* (ANYPAT).
2. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these conditions of entry. Entry is open to all residents of Australia aged between 10 and 25 years except employees and their immediate families of the Promoter (ANYPAT).
3. To enter you must answer all mandatory questions of the Youth Tobacco Free Day 2010 Online Competition. No more than one entry per person per competition is allowed.
4. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash.
5. Entry is only via the OxyGen website, www.OxyGen.org.au, from **February 1 and closes 5.00pm EST, 16 April 2010**. The winning entries will be drawn at random. Results are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. The Promoter is not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer on-line systems, servers, or providers, computer equipment, software, technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any web site, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to participants or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participation in or downloading any materials in this competition.

If for any reason this competition is not capable of running as planned including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupt or affect the administration security, fairness integrity or proper conduct of this competition, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition.
8. No responsibility accepted for late, lost or misdirected entries.

Completion and submission of contact details on the competition form will be deemed as acceptance by the entrant to the use and publication of their name, State/Territory for the purpose of the 'Youth Tobacco Free Day 2010 On-line Competition'. It will also be deemed that the entrant has consented to their name and postal address being available to ANYPAT, in the event that they are a winner, to enable the ANYPAT, to send them their prize.

For entrants under 18 years of age on **16 April 2010**, completion and submission of the online competition will be taken as the entrant's parent or legal guardian having given their consent to the entrant's submission in the Youth Tobacco Free Day 2010 On-line Competition, as well as the use and publication of their name, State/Territory for the purpose of the competition. It will also be deemed that the parent or legal guardian has given their consent to the entrant's name and postal address being forwarded to ANYPAT, in the event that they are a winner, to enable ANYPAT to send them their prize.
11. Winners will be notified by email and their names, State/Territory may be published on the website (www.OxyGen.org.au). Winners' names and postal addresses will be available to ANYPAT in order that they can send the prizes to the winners.
12. All entries become the property of the Promoter. The Promoter owns (including ownership of all intellectual property rights) all entries.
